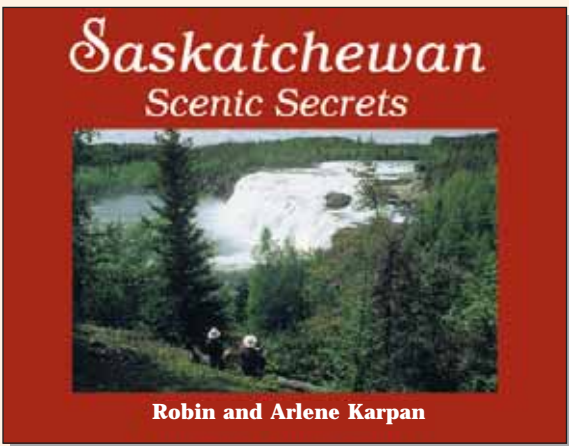

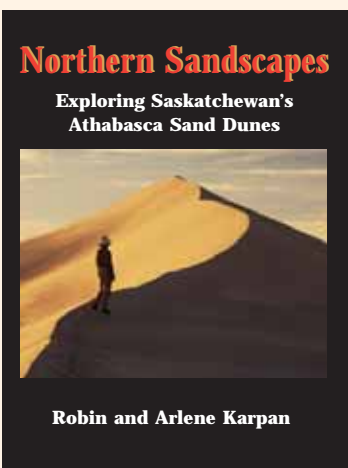

The hard cover coffee-table book features 230 stunning images of the northern wilderness, complemented by stories on the rich history, the tremendous diversity of landscapes, and the Karpans' personal experiences in canoeing and travelling the north.
